Recycling in Nebraska will be topic of statewide meetings



All interested Nebraskans are encouraged to take part in strategic planning workshops to enhance recycling throughout the state.

Meetings will be held in North Platte, Grand Island, Norfolk, and Omaha over the next month to hear the results of the statewide recycling study that's been conducted by the Joslyn Institute for Sustainable Communications, the Nebraska State Recycling Association, and the University of Nebraska.

The four free regional meetings will be forums for discussing the survey results, identifying strategies to increase and better recycling in Nebraska, and to determine next steps.
